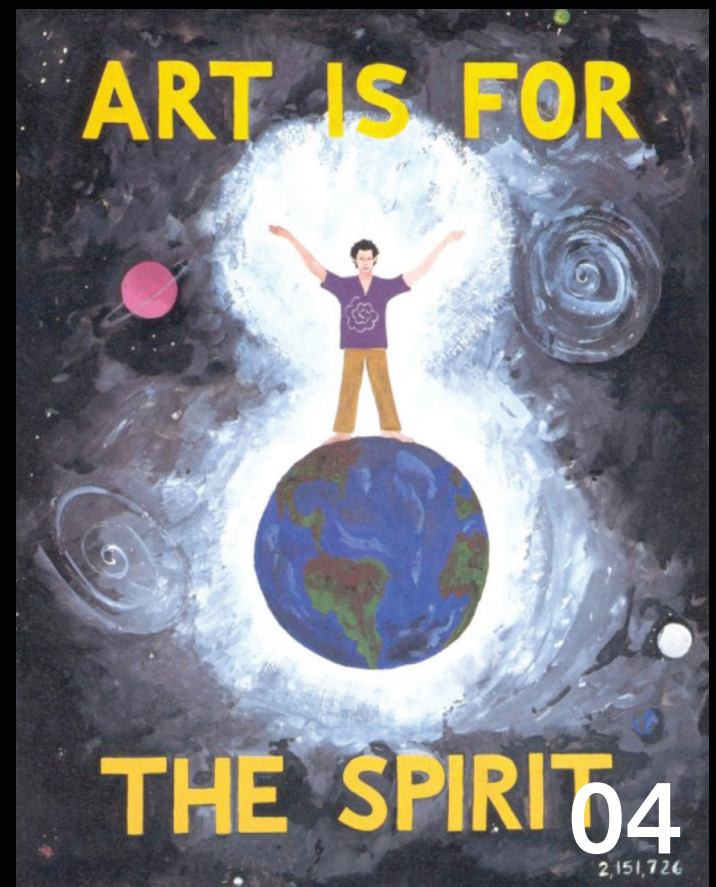
Welcome to Cleveland Clinic, and thank you for taking the Acoustiguide audio art tour.

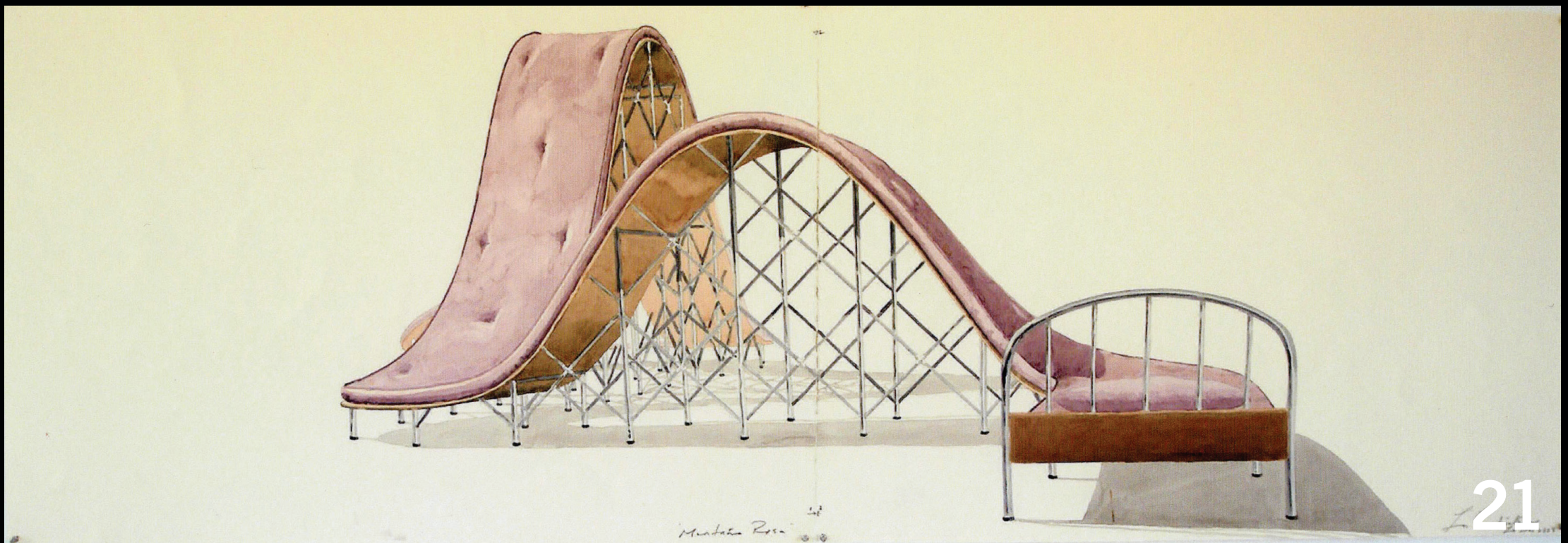

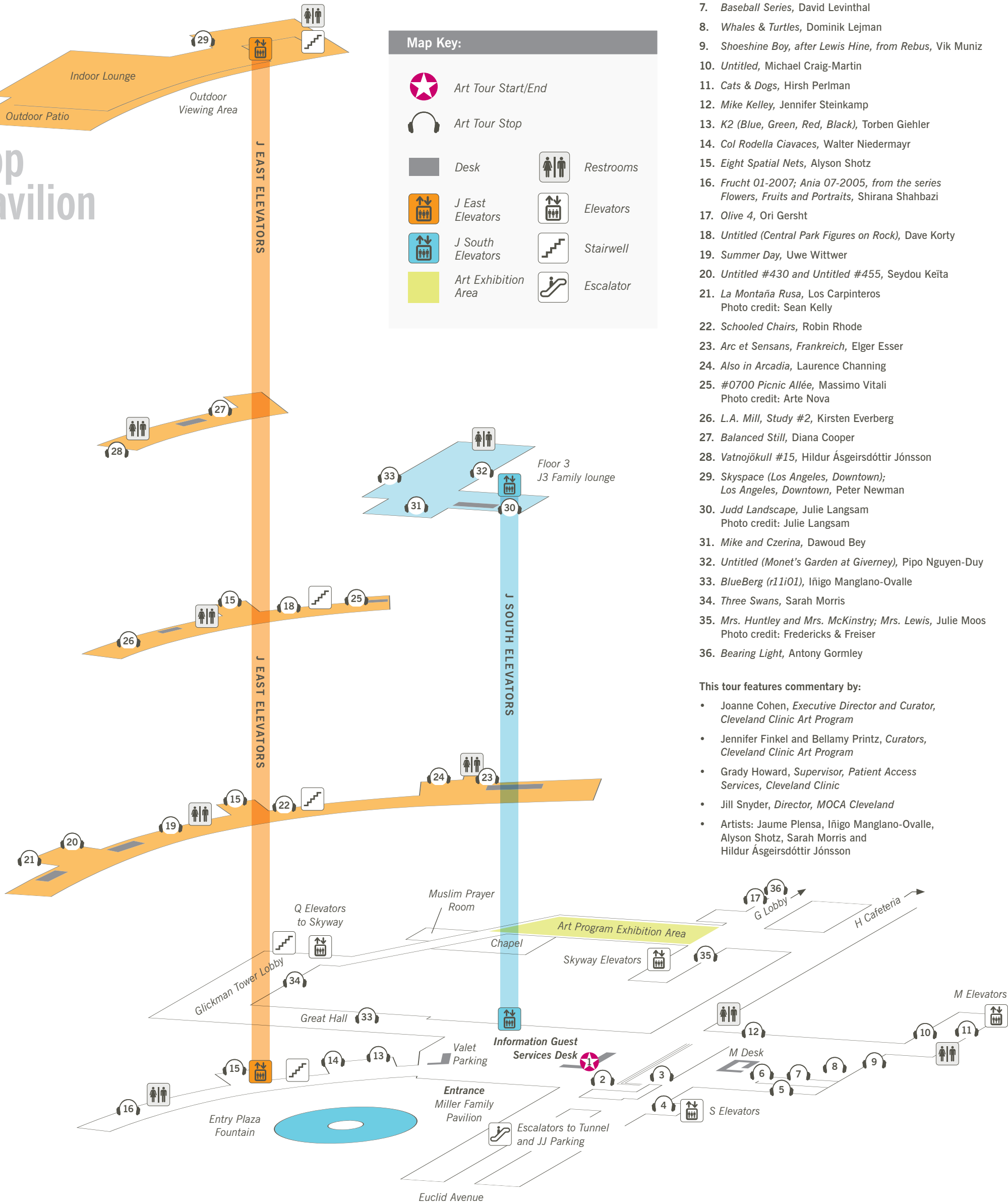

## How to Operate the Acoustiguide:

1. Select language: English, Spanish, Arabic
  2. Look for Audio Icon next to Artwork
  3. Enter Artwork Number
  4. Press Play
  5. Hold Acoustiguide to your ear
- \* Press 411 to listen to instructions

Remember to return your wand to the Information Guest Services Desk



## Curators' Suggested Route:

- Start Introduction near Cleveland Soul by Jaume Plensa, then view through on floor 1.
- Take the J East Elevators to floors 2, 3, 4 and Rooftop to view through (Note that Rooftop closes daily at 7 pm.)
- Return to floor 1 and take the J South Elevators to floor 3, J3 Family Lounge, to view through (33).
- Return to floor 1 to view (33) in the Great Hall and (34) in the Glickman Tower lobby.
- Continue past the Q Elevators and visit the Art Program Exhibition Area and stops (17), (35) and (36) near the G Lobby.
- Follow the signs back to the J Building and return the wand to Information Guest Services.
