Your 10-week externship will include working one-on-one with a nurse mentor, as well as time with fellow externs in a classroom setting.

Ideal candidates will be purpose-driven individuals who thrive on hard work and are committed to giving their best to make a meaningful difference in the lives of others. Student applicants must be currently enrolled in an accredited nursing school (BSN or BSN/MN program) and entering their last year or semester, or accredited ADN program entering their last semester upon completion of their externship. Candidates must hold Basic Life Support certification through the American Heart Association for the duration of the program.

Where and when is the externship available?

Externships are available at Cleveland Clinic's main campus and regional hospitals in Ohio and Florida. The 10-week program will be from June 5-August 12, 2023.

How can I apply?

Applications are now being accepted! Please visit clevelandclinic.jobs and search **194100** to submit your application and/or résumé. If you are a current caregiver, please be sure to indicate your Cleveland Clinic affiliation.

What can I expect after I submit my application?

All applications will be reviewed by a Cleveland Clinic nurse recruiter. If you meet the program requirements, you will be invited to complete an on-demand video interview. Finalists will move forward to meet with a virtual or live hiring manager.

What hours will I work?

As a Nurse Associate, you will be expected to work full time (40 hours per week). You will be scheduled for 8- or 12-hour shifts, depending on your nurse mentor's schedule.

Is the externship paid?

Yes, this externship is a paid opportunity.
